PROJECT READ COURSES

Phonics

 A decoding and encoding approach based on systematic phonics using multi-sensory strategies and materials delivered through direct, concept teaching. The sequence of concepts and skills progresses from the simplest to the most complex. The reading decoding curriculum is basic explicit Phonics starting with phonemic awareness, proceeding to sound/symbol correspondence, syllabication, and ultimately to context. Designed for primary level students, but is basic for any age person at a beginning level in decoding our written word.

APRIL 12-14, 2010

Written Expression

 The foundation of communication through written expression is the basic sentence. This course is designed to give students mastery of sentence structure as well as paragraph development and composition. Sentence structure is presented in a sequential order beginning with the simple sentence and moving to complex sentences using multi-sensory strategies to develop the basic concepts and skills of written expression. The curriculum can be started in grade one and is applicable through adult education.
